"Special Topics: The Athletic Actor" - Fall 2015

Contact Improv, Grotowski-based training, and Capoeira studied together in order to bring the actor into full, embodied performance. The Contact Improv training is in direct conversation with the Grotowski training, emphasizing the following of impulses moment-to-moment while allowing students to discover deep intimacy and vulnerability. Capoeira is presented in a "martial arts for the actor" model, all physical skills and concepts are directly related to acting work. Original MFA Thesis course.

"Acting I" - Spring 2015 & 2016

Based in the Stanislavski Acting System and utilizing the exercises of Sanford Meisner. A focus upon connection, impulse, invested circumstances, objectives, and tactics. An introduction to character work. Course includes Devised Group projects, two Scenes, a Monologue, and a Mock Audition.

"Introduction to Performance" - Fall & Spring 2014-2016

Undergraduate course designed to introduce the basic components of acting work including a training of physical and vocal presence. Developing basic acting skills through theater games, acting exercises, improvisation and simple scene study. A component of critical response to theatrical productions is also involved.

"World Theatre I" - Invited Lecture - Fall 2015

Taught one class focusing on the performance rituals of ancient Egypt and Mesoamerica. An examination of the ways in which the performances of these peoples reflected and supported the society's understanding of life, death, and creation.

"Acting III" - Invited Lecture - Fall 2015

Presented a workshop on Embodying lambic Pentameter. Introduced students to the poetic structure of Shakespeare's go-to meter and the reasons why it was utilized. The class was guided through a variety of games/exercises which put the performer into direct *physical* contact with the rhythm and momentum of iambic pentameter. Monologue work and application to a two-person scene.

"Stage Combat" - Invited Lecture - Spring 2015

Taught a workshop in Telekinetic Powers Combat for the Stage. Emphasis placed on precise body isolations, the use of breath, and connection with a partner. Students were introduced to fundamental techniques, basic vocabulary, and the class concluded in pairs performing choreography.
